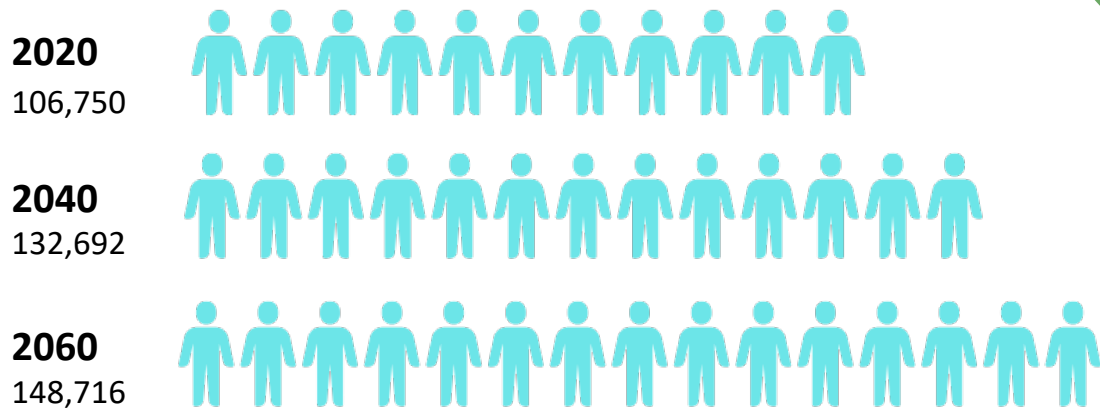
# Aging is changing and it's changing Solano...

80 years<sup>1</sup>

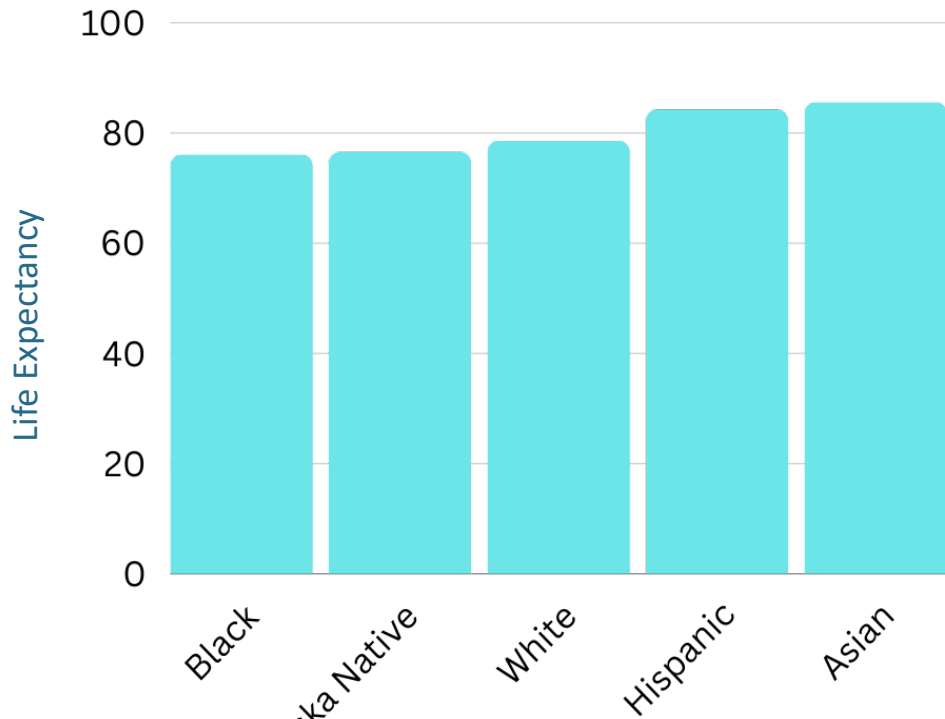


Number of Solano Residents age 60+ by year<sup>2</sup>:

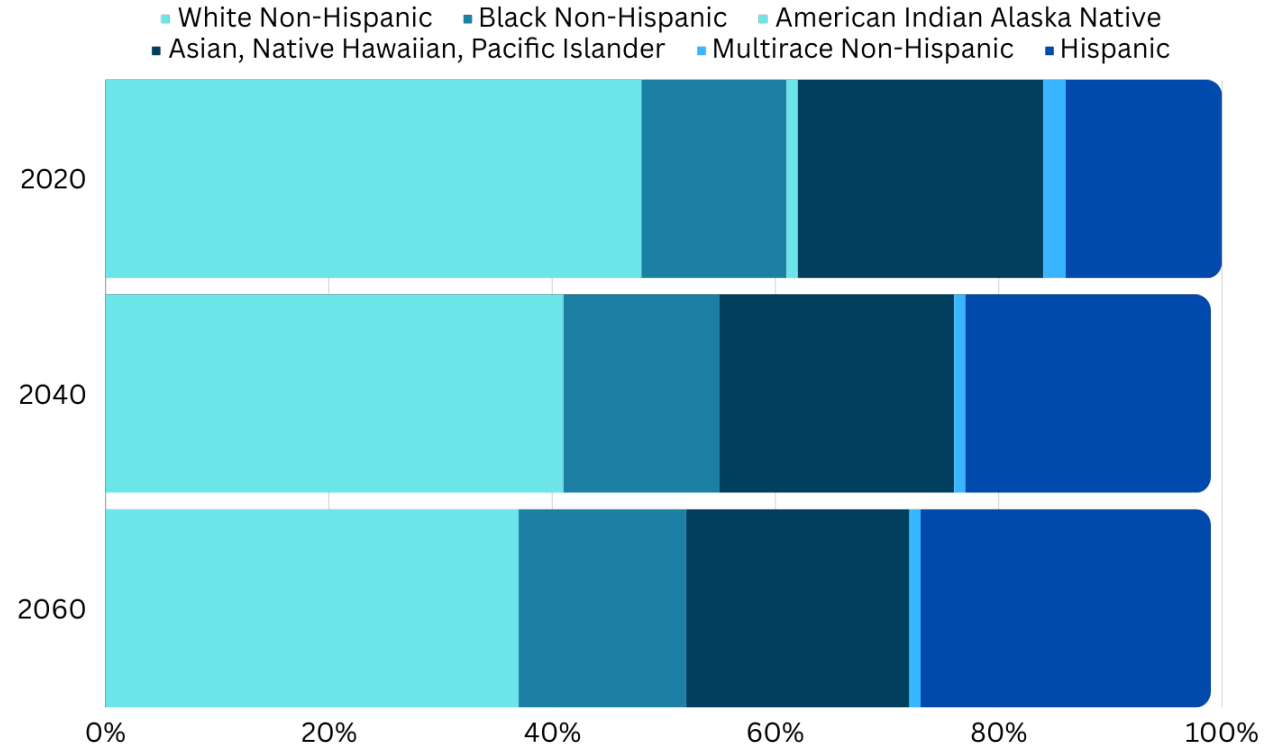

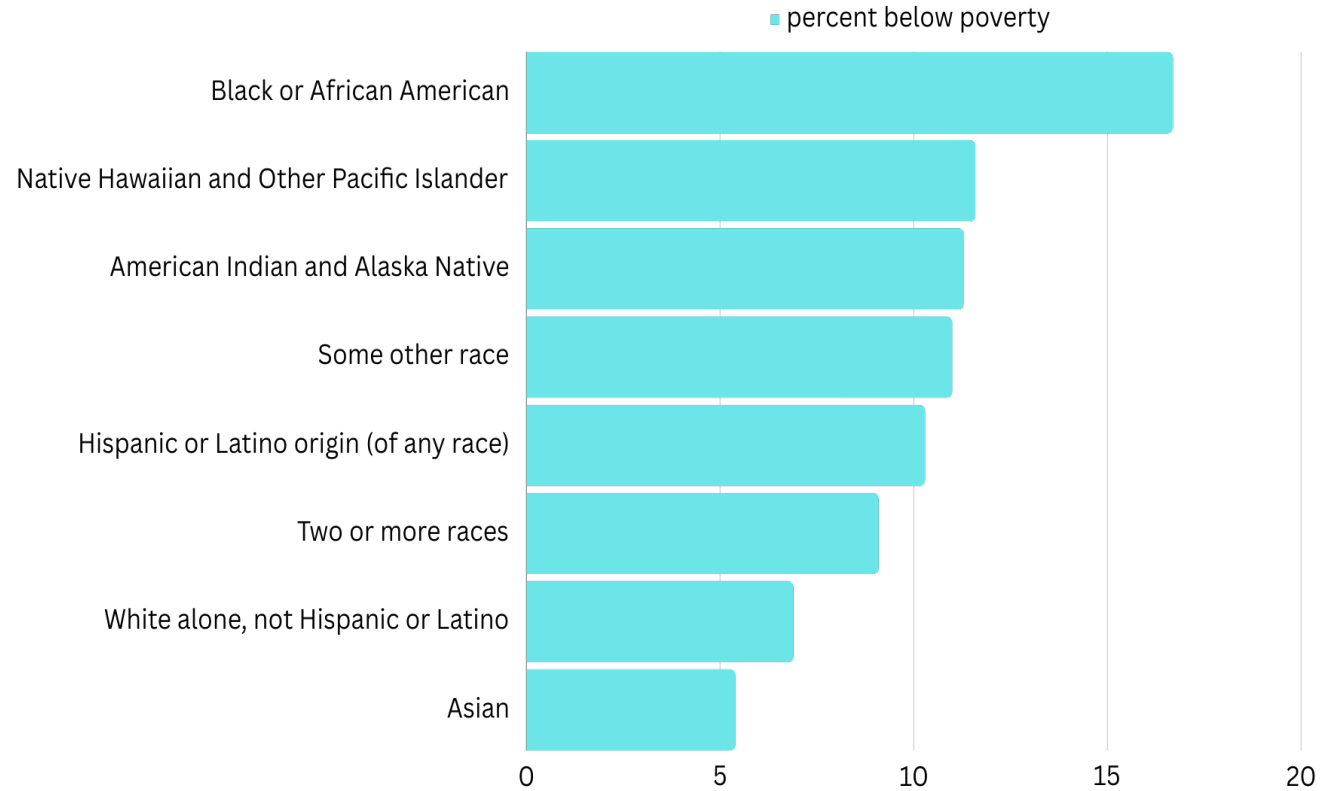
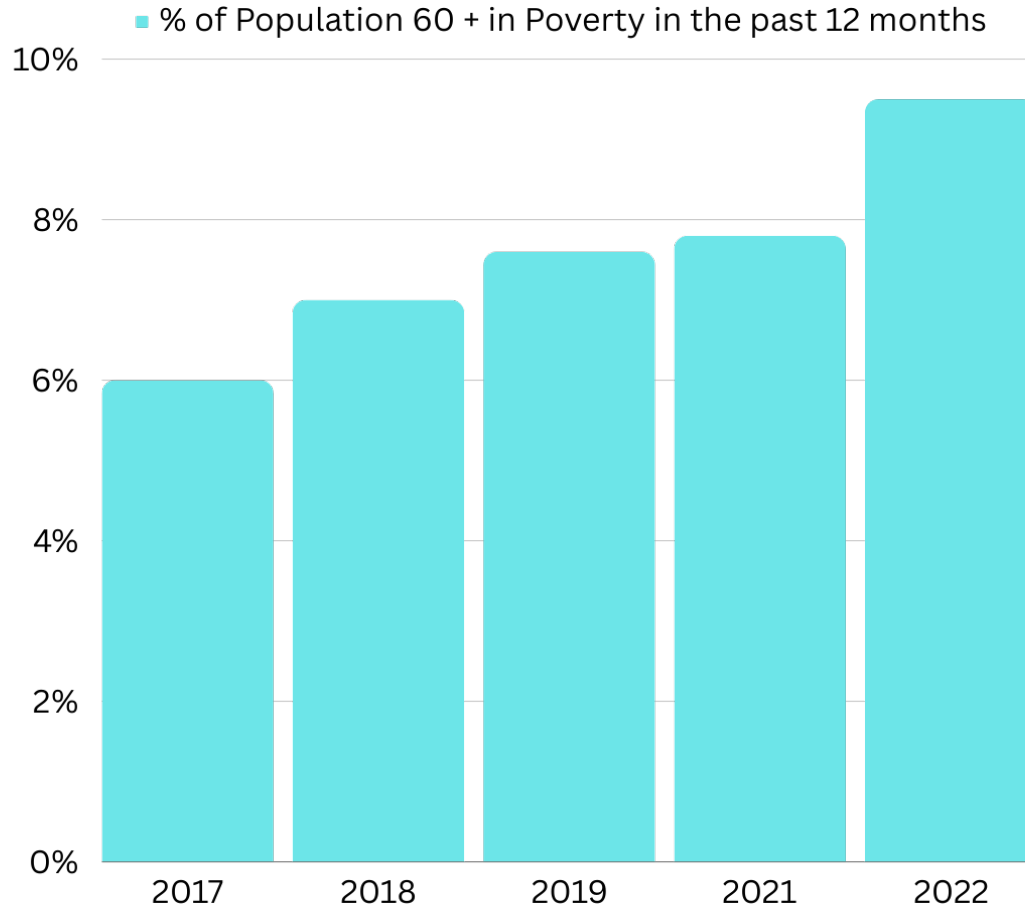
*...and Solano's 60+ population is becoming more racially & ethnically diverse<sup>2</sup>.*

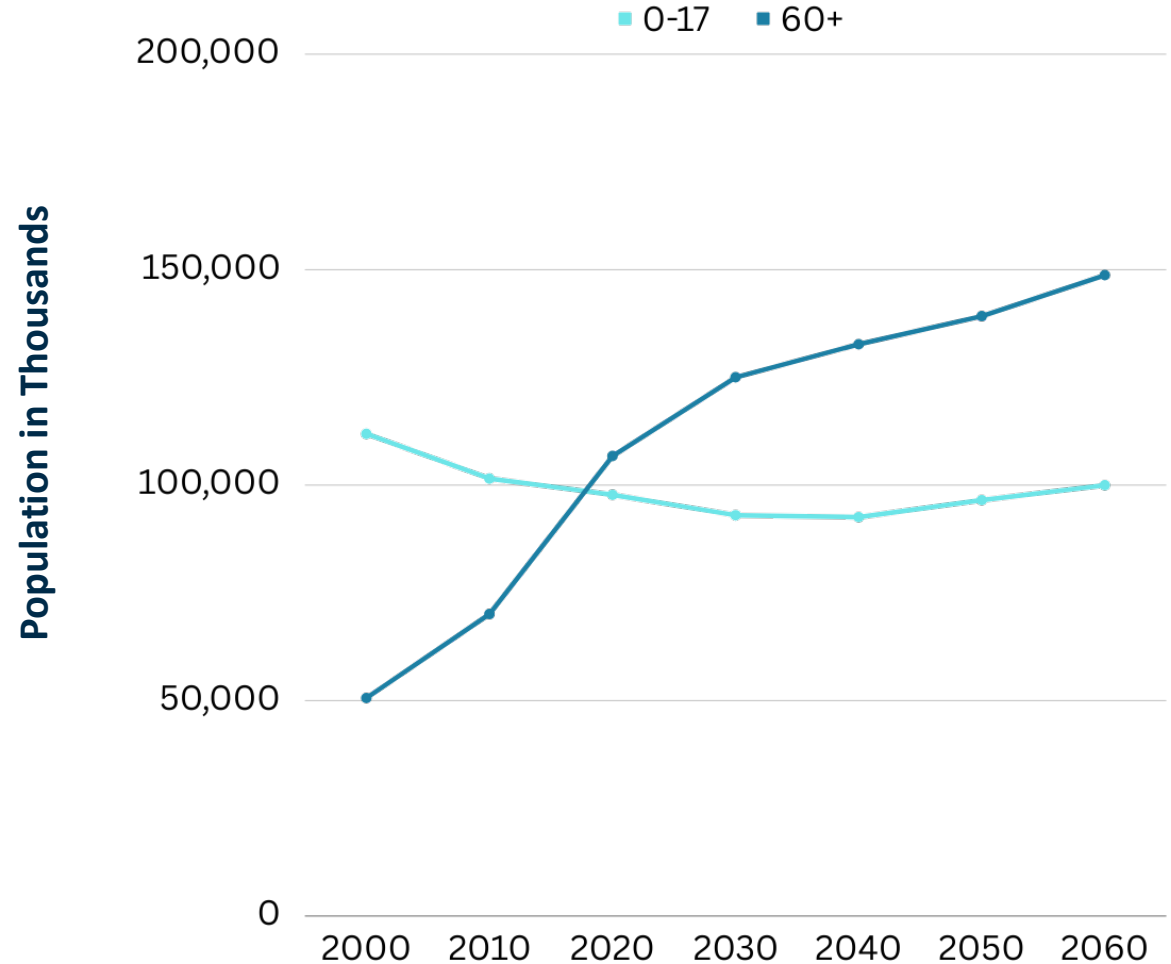
